At the same time, challenges such as water supply and water quality have suddenly become more immediate to citizens, who are now hearing about groundwater contamination, floods, and oxygen depletion in coastal sea areas.

At the meeting on the May 16, we will discuss how local solutions contribute to a more sustainable water sector and how these experiences can be applied internationally.
